Background: The NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has proposed opening nearly 85% of the Marcellus Shale to natural gas drilling. The current form of natural gas drilling is known as Hydrofracking, a practice that has raised numerous environmental and health concerns. A 90-day public comment period on the DEC's Draft Proposals will be ending on December 12, 2011.
